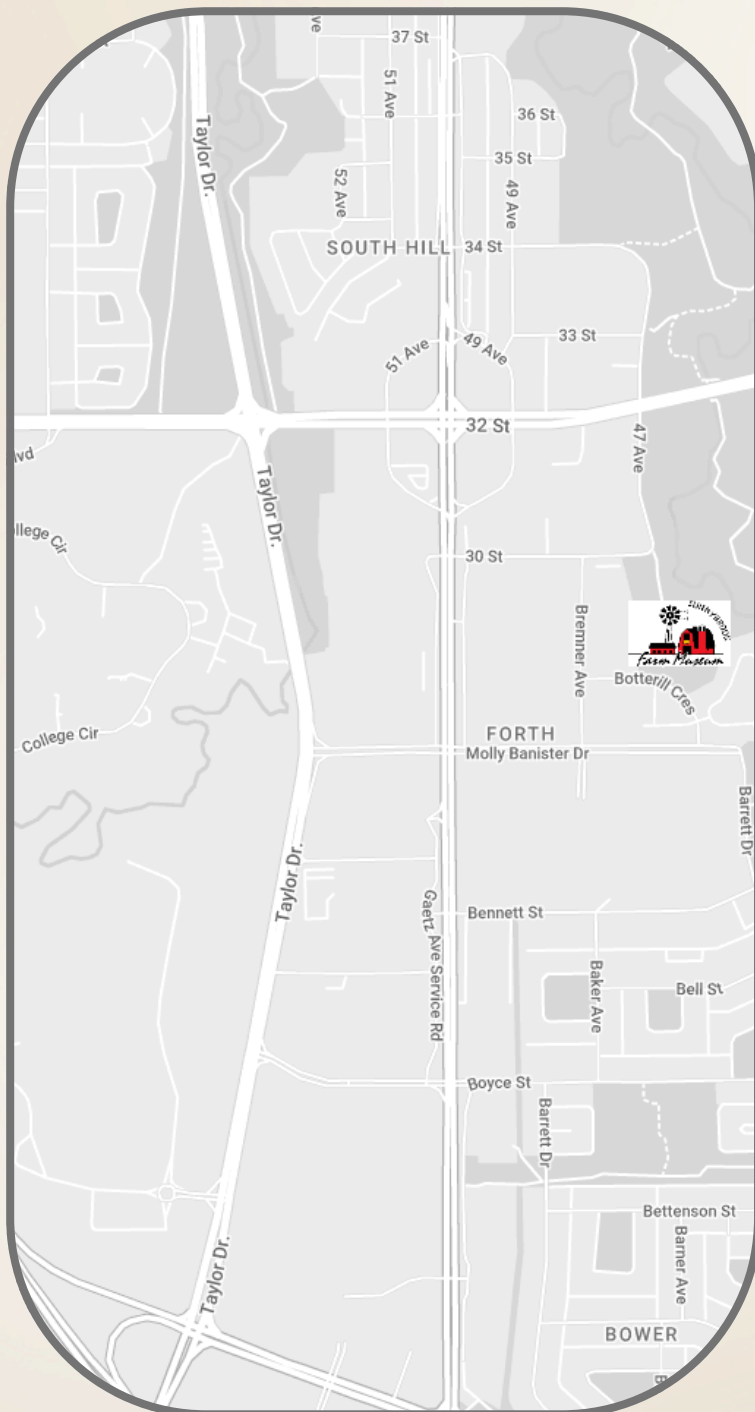




## CELEBRATE TIMELESS ROMANCE

# HOW TO FIND US



Sunnybrook Farm Museum is located at 2879 Botterill Crescent in Red Deer, Alberta. From the Queen Elizabeth II Highway (Highway 2), take the 32 Street exit eastbound, then turn right to head south on Gaetz Avenue. Take your second left onto Molly Banister Drive and then turn left onto Bremner Avenue. Turn right onto Botterill Crescent (between Mission Thift Store and the Sims Furniture Building). Follow signs to the entrance, where convenient parking awaits. This central location makes Sunnybrook Farm Museum a charming historic destination right within the city.

### WEDDING \$1000 PACKAGE

Exclusive Access to the 10-Acre Museum Site (9am-2am)

Ceremony spaces are available throughout the site:

- Willowdale Church (seats 40-50)
- Outside the Hanna Log House (up to a 40 ft tent can be set up)
- Museum Main Street (up to a 60ft by 100 ft tent can be set up)

Optional use of:

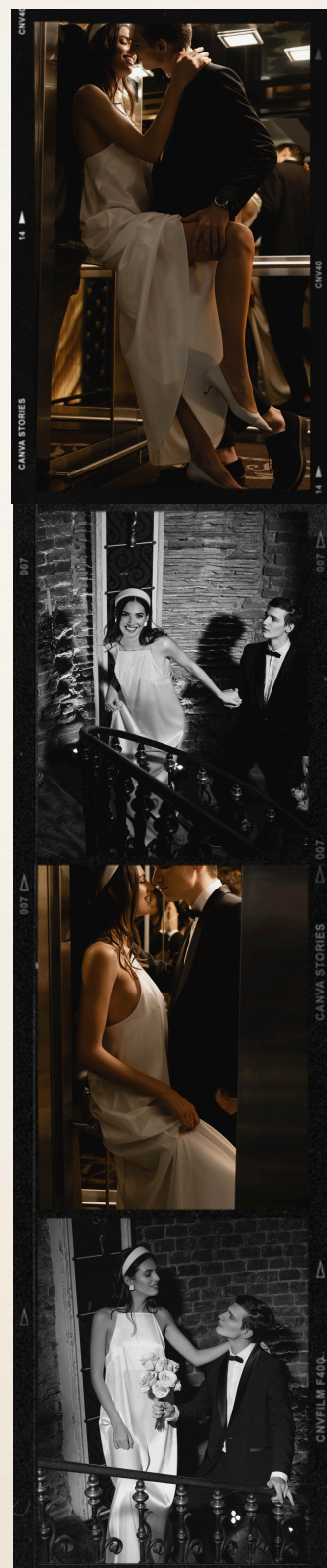
- Calder School Hall for an indoor reception (seats 50); June to August)
- Calder School Classroom for reception dance

Set Up of Tables & Chairs in the Calder School Hall

- up to 8 rectangular tables (seats 4 on the long side), including 2 for buffet service
- up to 50 Banquet Style round back chairs

Calder school is air conditioned

Indoor washrooms on the site and in the Calder School



# WEDDING *pricelist*

## ADD ONS AND ADDITIONAL FEES

Previous day decorating/Rehearsal

- \$50 per hour, minimum of 3 hours

Kitchen or Concession Access

- \$50 One time fee per location

Antique Tractor Rides

- \$100 per hour

Barrel Train Rides

- \$50 per hour
- Children Only (up to 100lbs)
- Not to be ridden by adults

Damage Deposit

- \$500, non-refundable deposit is to be paid at the time of signing the agreement



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# HELPFUL *Details*

The total bill will be invoiced and must be paid one week in advance. Any and all NSF payments are subject to a \$50 service charge

Credit Card information on file is required. Additional charges apply for early set-up, early drop-off, late departure, and excessive clean-up requirements.

The Lessee must provide proof of possessing a special events liability insurance policy. **Friends of Sunnybrook Farm Society** MUST be named as an additional insured with respect to this agreement. The office MUST receive this at least one week prior to your event. No event shall take place on the property without this insurance coverage.

If you intend to have alcohol service at your event, you are responsible for obtaining a liquor permit. We require a copy of the permit before the event begins. A copy must also be displayed at the bar.

All bartenders must have their ProServe certification



# DECORATION *Policy*

The Lessee is responsible for obtaining any decorations, linen, glassware, dinnerware, cutlery, and equipment required for their event. Items may be dropped off at the museum with advance notice.

For the health and safety of our animals, we ask that lessees do not use confetti at events (organic materials such as flower petals, birdseed, or rice are allowed)

Do NOT feed the animals

Inside the exhibition buildings, no hooks, nails, pins, tape, or other fasteners are permitted to be used on the walls or artifacts.



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# CANCELLATION *Policy*

The Lessee must notify Sunnybrook in writing of a cancellation of the Event. Any notice of cancellation by the Lessee results in the loss of the \$500 non-refundable damage deposit. Any cancellation within 1 week of the event results in the loss of full payment.

The Lessee shall be responsible for the control and behaviour of the attendees. Further to this, the lessee will ensure that the museum site is vacated no later than 1:30am and gates locked by 2am. Failure to comply will result in the loss of the entire damage deposit.
